BACKGROUND

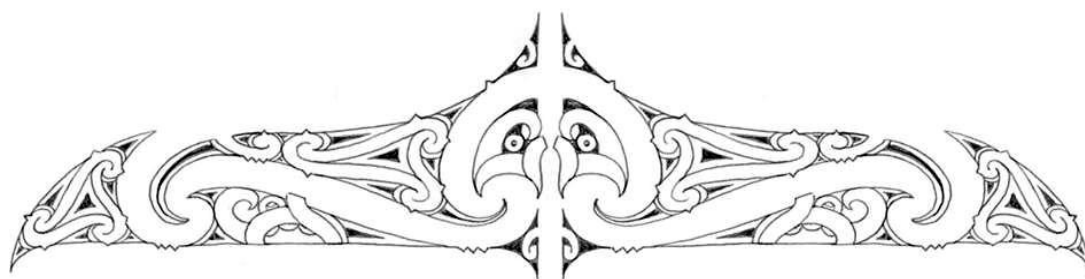
