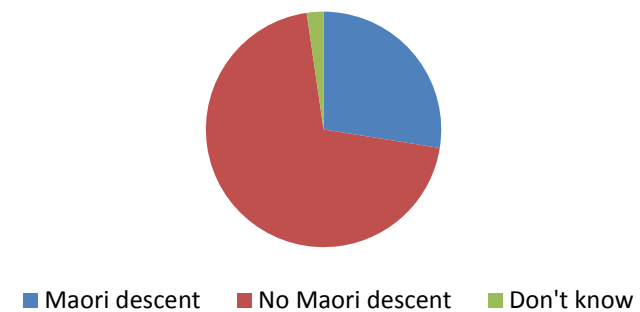

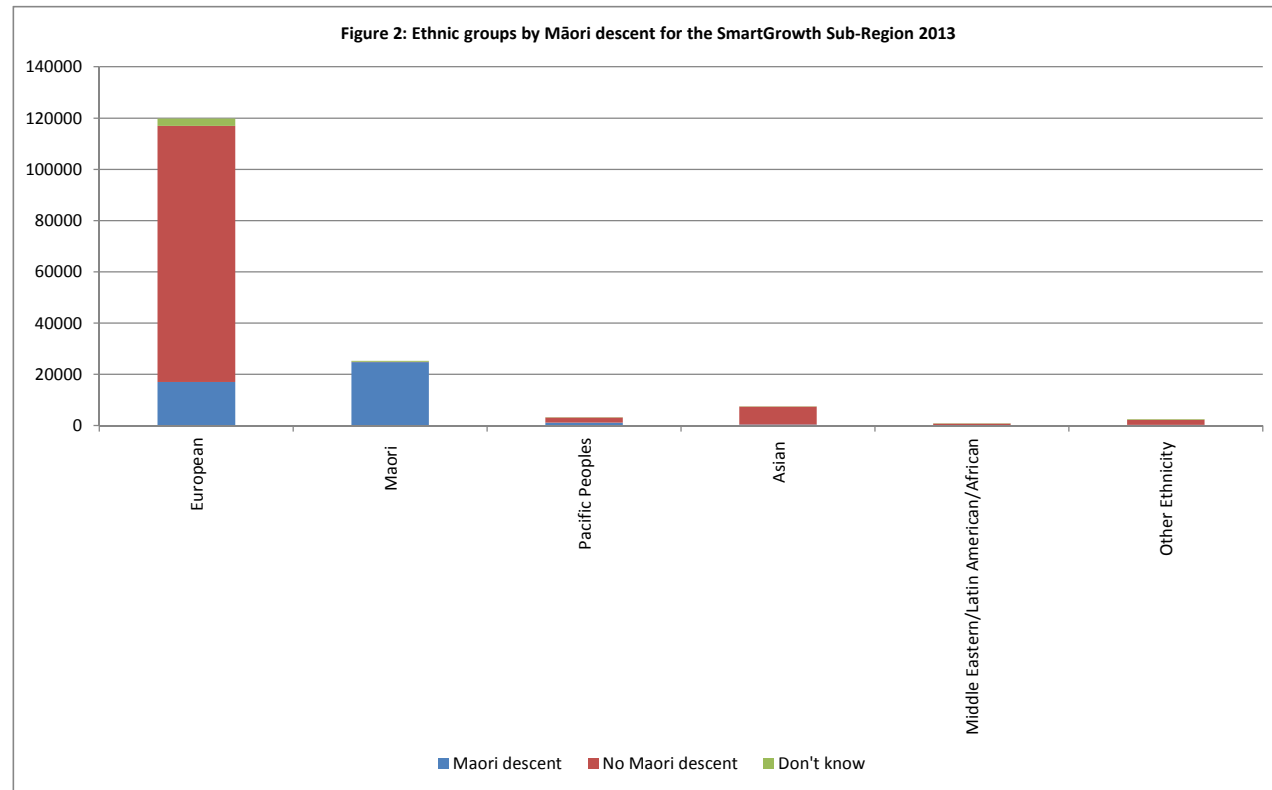

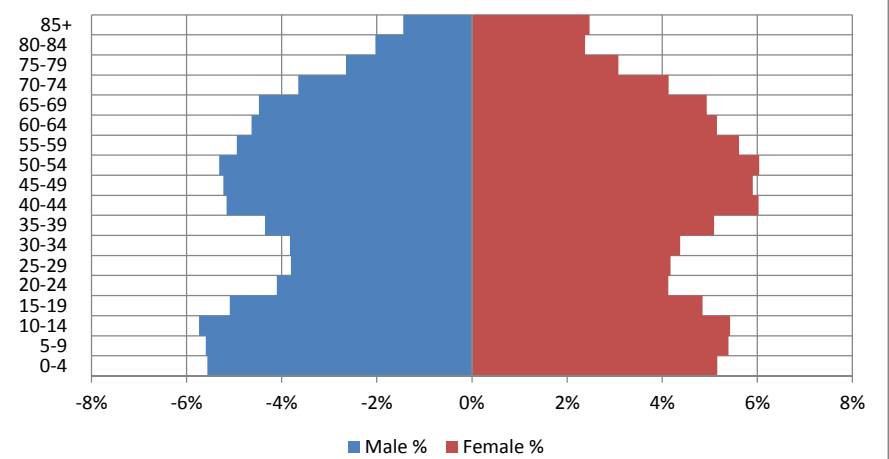

Figure 3: Age/Sex structure for the Sub-Region by total population 2013

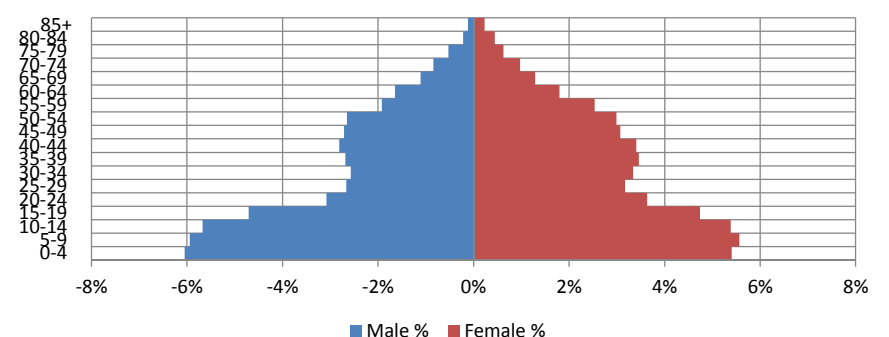

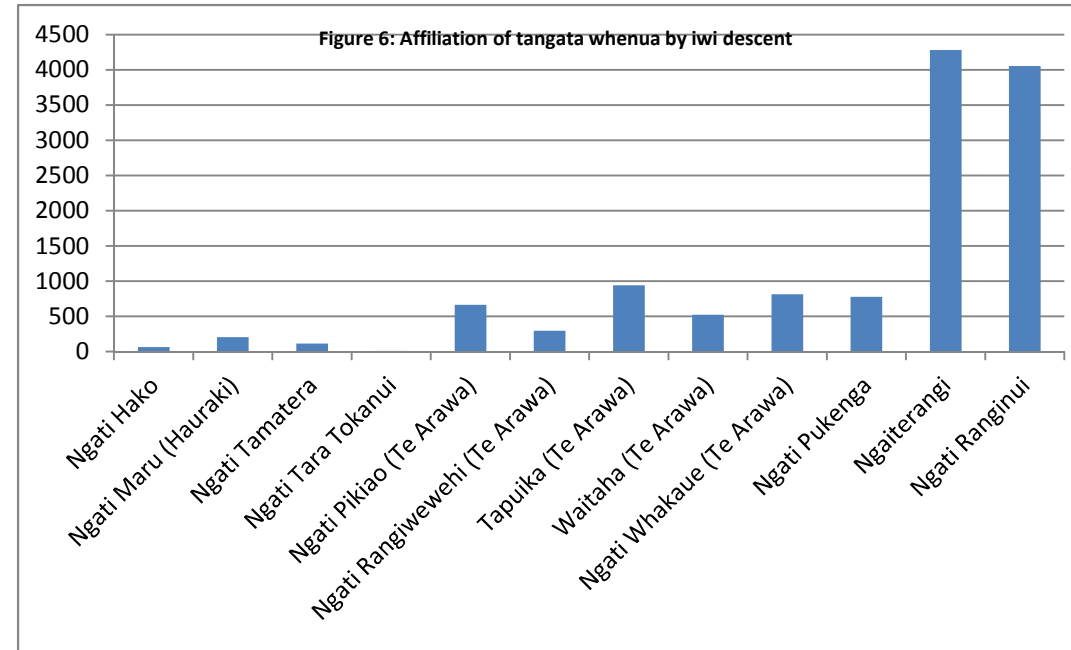

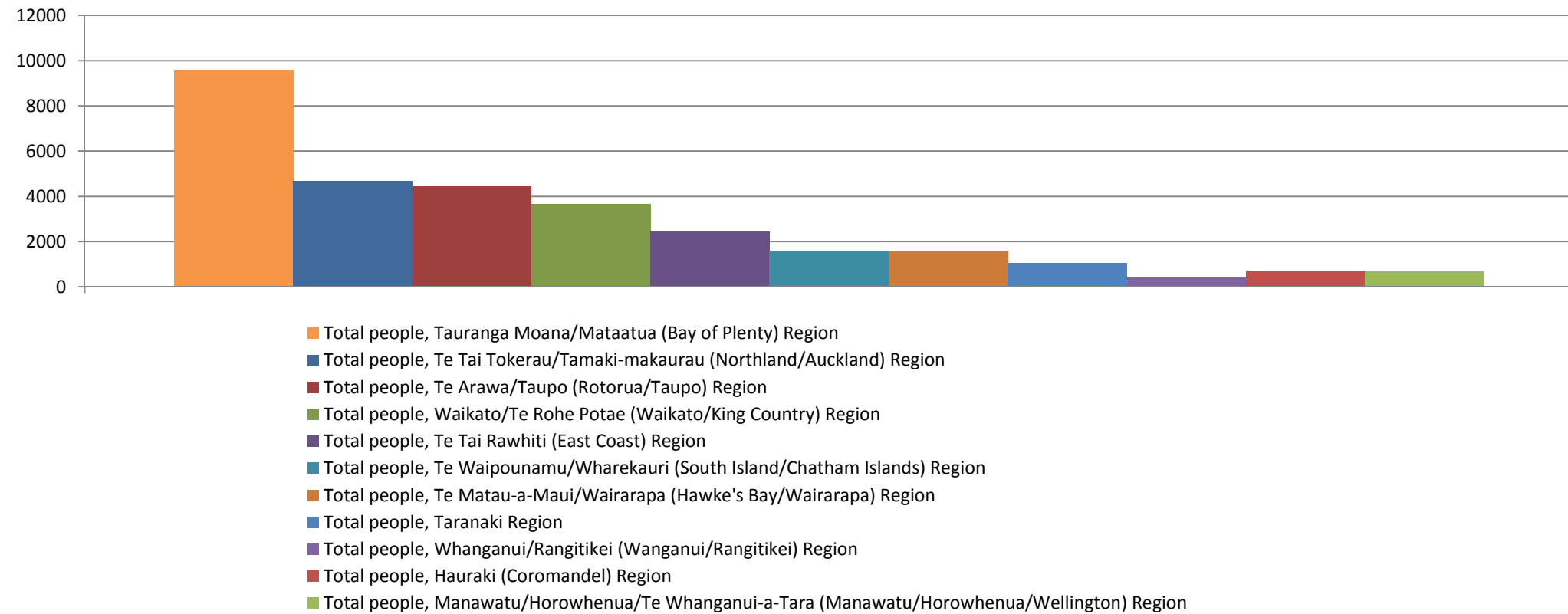

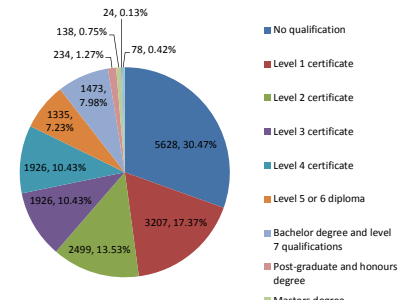

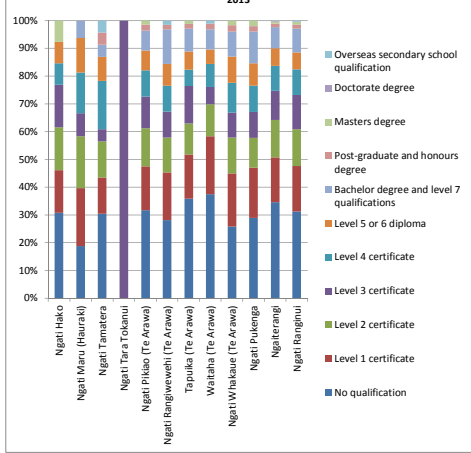

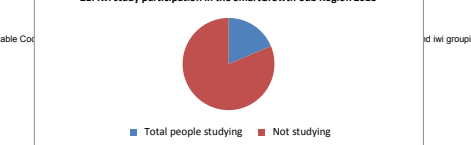

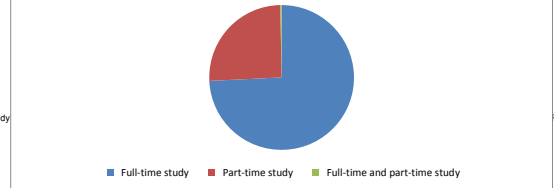
20. Percentage of level of iwi qualifications for the SmartGrowth Sub Region 2013

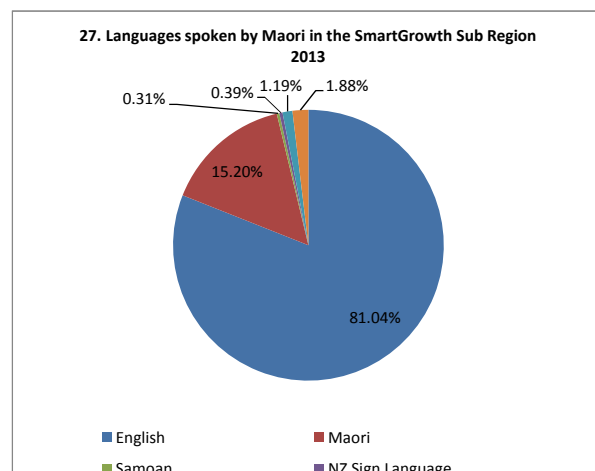
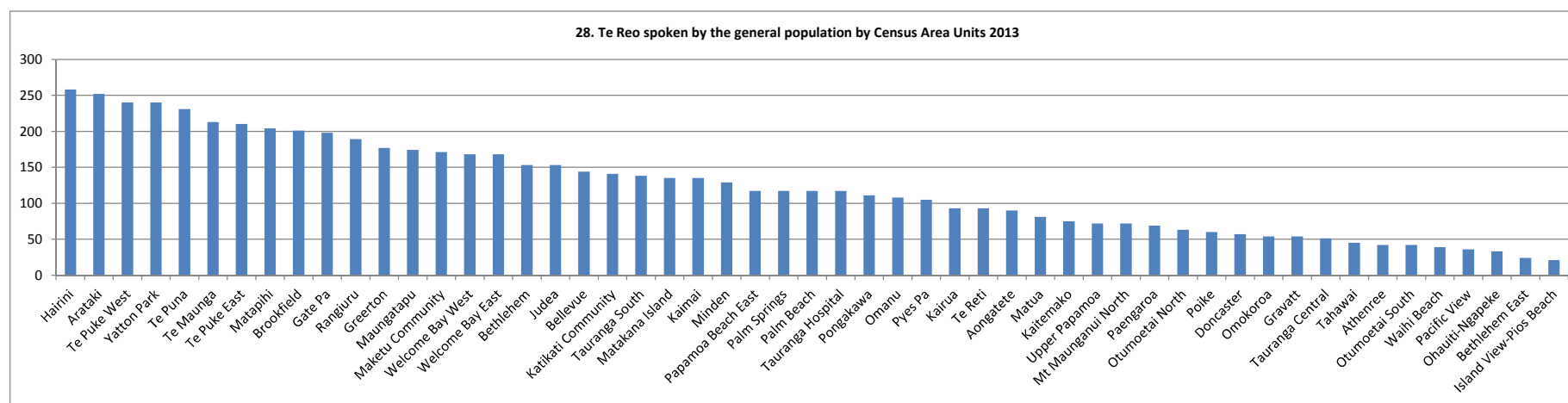
