## Introduction to Maps

The maps in the Ngati Rangitihi Iwi Environmental Plan are in four series. The first series is a map showing the ancestral interests of Ngati Rangitihi. The second series is the result of a significant exercise to identify and record Ngāti Rangitihi places of significance and customary resource areas. These are called Nga Rawa Whakahira o Ngāti Rangitihi (Important resources of Ngati Rangitihi). The third series of maps are statutory and planning mechanisms including a conglomeration of district planning zones, identification of significant ecological, cultural, and historic resources as well as designations and reserves. The fourth series map is statutory acknowledgements of other iwi.

Whilst every effort had gone into identifying as many places as possible their still remains a number that for reasons of sensitivity, accuracy and time constraints have not been added at this time. The schedules and maps will be reviewed and updated from periodically.

1. Rohe Map – identifying geographic extent of most of Ngati Rangitihi ancestral interests
2. Nga Rawa Whakahira o Ngati Rangitihi – identifying the places of significance, customary resource area, archaeological resources and water bodies of significance to Ngati Rangitihi
3. Statutory and Planning Mechanisms – the various statutory and planning mechanisms such as zoning, designations
4. Statutory Acknowledgements – geographic location of other iwi statutory acknowledgements as a result of settlement legislation.
